CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will offer four evening and weekend spring semester courses in Mattoon beginning Jan. 16.

Abnormal Behavior, an undergraduate course, will be offered at Mattoon High School from 7 to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesdays.

Two other undergraduate courses will be offered at Lakeland College.
