#### B. Chair Discussion Items

- 1. Revised schedules for Spring, Summer, and Fall 2013 were distributed for feedback. Spring and Summer are set; Fall conflicts need to be brought to Gail's attention.
- 2. The DAC Revision Committee (Goldacker, Ellis, Fahy, Throneburg, McNamara) has completed revisions to the document. Gail will review it and faculty will approve by an electronic vote.
- 3. There are seven applicants for the faculty position, although not all are completed at this point in time. The Search Committee will meet to review applications on Monday, December 17 at 8:00.
- 4. A summary of Undergraduate Research Awards was distributed. Megan Tredway (Brenda Wilson), Karissa Genebacher (Jill Fahy), and Meredith Healy (Lynn Calvert) were recipients from CDS.
- 5. Praxis summary information for graduate students showed institution averages above the national and state averages in all areas except Basic Human Communication Processes.
- 6. Departmental Scholarship decisions for fall awards were Margaret Xenakis for the Margaret Hollowell and Jenna Didier for the Ryan Struebing. Gail spoke on Friday, December 7 to the Decatur Breakfast Sertoma Club, which is sponsoring a new student departmental scholarship that should be approved at the February Foundation meeting. Revisions to the Rose Marie Coon Scholarship should also be approved at that meeting. Both could then be selected in the spring for financial distribution next fall.
- 7. Faculty were reminded to do grade checks next week and let Frank and Gail know of any students who has dropped below the minimum required grade points.
- 8. Gail distributed a copy of a memo from Provost Lord regarding the responsible conduct of research.
- 9. Graduate assistant assignments for fall were reviewed for the report to the Graduate School.
- 10. Faculty shared departmental data with Dean Ornes and discussed individual areas of strength and focus.

- 1. Clinic

- 2. Curriculum: Several departmental curricular revisions were approved at the COSCC meeting on Friday, December 7. Undergraduate revisions to the major include the new requirement for a statistics class and alternate course for ELE 2320. Graduate revisions include revisions to the internship experiences to accommodate the non-teacher certification option.
- 3. Assessment

  - b. Becky distributed expanded notes for use of the Writing rubric that might be helpful for the 2000 level classes. It is also on file on the Faculty drive.
