EIU OFFERS COURSE IN TUSCOLA

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University is offering a course at Tuscola High School on Thursday evenings during the spring semester that begins Jan. 13.

This course will support Eastern's Bachelor of Science in Career Occupations program, which enables individuals to complete an undergraduate degree through building on two years of community college credit with upper division courses and portfolio credit for learning gained through work experiences.

"Process Reengineering and Quality Management" (COS 4850-123) introduces learners to basic concepts involved in the reengineering of business processes. Topics covered include the common themes and fundamental differences between process reengineering concepts and quality management theories. The reasons for the failure of reengineering efforts and quality initiatives will be explored. Effective strategies for the management of change and the manager's role in a changing organizational environment will be emphasized.
