CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will offer seven evening and weekend spring semester courses in Rantoul beginning Jan. 16.

Graduate courses offered at Rantoul High School from 7 to 9:30 p.m. are Curriculum Development on Thursdays, beginning Jan. 18; Counseling the Chemically Dependent on Mondays, beginning Jan. 22; Introduction to Family Counseling on Tuesdays, beginning Jan. 16; Current Practices and Problems in Counseling on Thursdays, beginning Jan. 18; and Measurement Applied to Guidance on Wednesdays, beginning Jan. 17.

Two undergraduate courses also offered at Rantoul High School are Gangs in Contemporary Society from 6 to 10 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 26, and from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 27; and Facilitating Interpersonal Relationships from 6 to 10 p.m. on Friday and from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday on the weekends of March 1-2, March 8-9 and March 15-16.
