CHARLESTON, ILL.--Dr. Margaret Soderberg, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs at Eastern Illinois University, has resigned to become Vice President for Academic Affairs at North Adams (Mass.) State College.

Dr. Soderberg joined Eastern's faculty in 1962 as Assistant Professor of Political Science. Since that time she has held a number of administrative positions, including Acting Vice President for Academic Affairs. Administrative Assistant to President Dan Marvin, and Department Chairperson.

She holds the Ph.D. degree from Washington University, the Masters of Arts degree from Wayne State, the Master of Science in Library Science from Catholic University of America, and the Bachelor of Arts degree from Marygrove College.

Dr. Soderberg is a former Carnegie Research Fellow and a research assistant to the Ford Foundation. She also is a recipient of a "distinguished faculty" award at Eastern.
