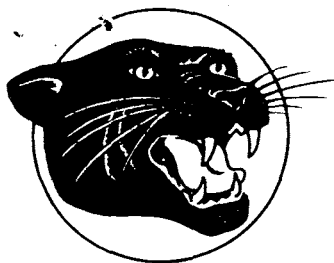

## PANTHER BASKETBALL REPORT

THE GAME: Eastern Illinois University (4-7) hosts William Penn (1-6) at 7:30, Wednesday, Jan. 6, Lantz Gym, Charleston, IL.

THE SERIES: EIU leads the series, 1-0, defeating the Statesmen, 91-60, during the 1976-77 season.

HOLIDAY GAMES: The Panthers won just one of four games during the holidays . . . prior to Christmas they lost to Illinois State (94-55), took third in the Evansville Holiday Tournament by losing to Murray State (71-70) but beating Tennessee Tech (68-67) and then lost to Indiana State (88-64).

FINALLY HOME: After playing nine of their first 11 on the road (two were neutral), the Panthers return home for 10 of their final 16 games.

EDDIE JONES RETURNS: Eddie Jones (Chicago-Cregier/Lincoln CC) has returned to the lineup after sitting out two games with a strained knee.

KEVIN JONES ALL-TOURNAMENT: Kevin Jones (Indianapolis, IN-Kankakee CC) was named to the Evansville Holiday All-Tournament Team after scoring 39 points and 13 rebounds in the two games. He led the Panthers in scoring five straight games before slumping with just three points in the Indiana State loss Saturday.

TOUGH LOSSES: Three of EIU's losses have been by two points or less and another in overtime so four of the seven losses have been in the last seconds. Over the past two years ten of the 18 losses have been last second affairs.

WILLIAM PENN FACTS: The Statesmen are 1-6 with their only win in their latest outing, 89-82, over Maryville College. They have been idle for almost one month. Senior guard Kirk Listebarger leads with a 13 point average followed by 'sixth' man Earl Parker at ten points even.

RICK SAMUELS SAYS: "We're still searching for a starting lineup that will get us off on the right track so that we're not ten down early and constantly having to fight back . . . we haven't run the offense very well and with five seniors playing most of the time we're disappointed by that . . . but we think returning home will allow us to develop a more stable routine which will hopefully produce more consistent play."
