EASTERN VOLUNTEERS TO HELP MARCH OF DIMES

CHARLESTON, IL--Members of Eastern Illinois University's Delta Sigma Phi Fraternity will be collecting donations from motorists on Lincoln Avenue near the University Saturday (Feb. 2) and Sunday (Feb. 3) to raise money for the March of Dimes.

Brian Owen, vice-president of Delta Sigma Phi and event coordinator, said the pledge class raised \$400 for the March of Dimes last semester and also said, "It is our goal to raise \$1000 this time." The money will go towards research to prevent birth defects.

Numerous fraternity volunteers will be at the intersections of 4th Street and Lincoln Avenue and at University Drive and Lincoln. The chapter has been granted a permit by the city of Charleston to conduct the fundraiser.
