CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University President Stanley Rives will participate Wednesday in the dedication of a building in Bloomington which houses the central kitchen for Eastern's Peace Meal Senior Nutrition Program.

Mrs. Evelyn Kaufman, Chair of the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities, will be among the speakers.

The peace meal project, under the direction of Mike Strader, dispenses more than 400 meals daily through 11 sites in three counties.

The new structure, located at 1003 Maple Hill Road, Route 12, is the home of the East Central Illinois Agency on Aging.

An open house is scheduled from 1 to 5 p.m. with dedication ceremonies beginning at 2 p.m.

Strader was heavily involved with planning the kitchen and describes it "as excellent in all respects for the peace meal program."
