Quadrangle: Secor Mackinaw River Watershed

Parklands Foundation's Chinquapin Bluffs Preserve; located approximately 5 miles north of Carlock, Illinois. Map Datum: WGS84/NAD83.

Mesic Floodplain Forest Community dominated by *Fraxinus lanceolata*, *Ulmus americana*, *Rudbeckia laciniata*, and *Laportea canadensis*. Associated species include: *Tilia americana*, *Ulmus rubra*, *Platanus occidentalis*, *Crataegus mollis*, *Prunus virginiana*, *Euonymus atropurpureus*, *Viburnum prunifolium*, *Smilax tamnoides*, *Urtica gracilis*, *Sanicula odorata*, *Galium aparine*, *Phlox divaricata*, *Claytonia virginica*, and *Cryptotaenia canadensis*. Fruiting heavily.
