Aceraceae

Det.: S.R.Hill. (ILLS) 2003 Chalk maple.

**PICKENS COUNTY** 34° 44.823' N. Lat. 82° 48.998' W. Long. Along Todd's Creek west of Brookbend Road crossing, about 5 miles north of junction of South Carolina Route 133 and US Route 123/76, Clemson. Elevation about 730-750 feet. Upper Piedmont; moist humus over gneissic granite bedrock and talus, north-facing slopes of lower creek near spring.

Mesic forest, seeps, and creek terrace, with *Quercus* spp., *Pinus* spp., *Carpinus*, *Xanthorhiza*, *Alnus*, *Halesia*, *Fagus*; shaded. Occasional small tree 4-8 m tall, low-branched; flowers pale green, pendulous, emerging with leaves; bark pale grey, smooth.
