#### AL MOLDE Head Coach

Al Molde, 39, who has developed three collegiate football teams into winners, was named head football coach at EIU in Mid-January. He replaced Darrell Mudra who had resigned in December to accept the head position at Northern Iowa.

Molde most recently was head coach and athletic director for three seasons at Central Missouri State, and prior to that coached three NCAA playoff teams at Minnesota-Morris. His 74-42-6 overall record (63%) was 14th best among NCAA II coaches while eligible for that category at CMS. At Minn-Morris he was the Northern Intercollegiate Conference 'Coach of the Year' four consecutive seasons as it won four straight undefeated conference titles. He took over a program at Central Missouri that had not been over .500 in ten years and went 6-3-1 his first season.

He and his wife, Ingrid, have four sons, Michael (13), Brian (11), Matthew (6) and Evan (4).
