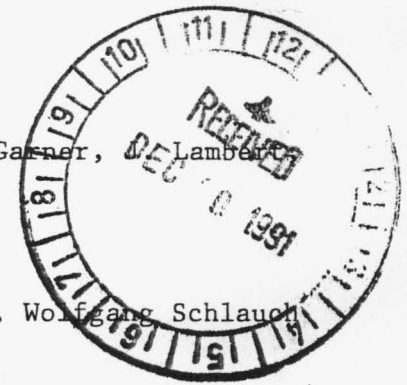
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MINUTES OF THE COE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE
December 5, 1991

Minutes - The minutes of November 21, 1991 were unanimously approved. Minutes from the Applied Science Curriculum Committee were distributed.

Item 92-8 - Study Abroad 3970/5970 Proposal

Dr. Schlauch, Study Abroad Coordinator, stated that Study Abroad courses are now offered only in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences. For faculty in departments wishing to provide credit for Study Abroad, proposed courses should be presented well in advance (9-15 months) for approval by the Department Curriculum Committee, Chair, Dean of the College, and then forwarded to the Study Abroad Committee, VPAA, and the Dean of Adult and Continuing Education. Study Abroad 5970 which would provide graduate credit, would also need approval from the Graduate Dean. Approved proposals will be listed in the Catalog with an EIU prefix for a maximum of 15 s.h. credit under the auspices of the offering Department. Dr. Schlauch indicated that CU's have been provided in the past to individual faculty members who have developed various course offerings. The Continuing Education Office presently handles all the details.

Chair Cooper requested that COECC members meet with their respective departments for reactions to this proposal. Action on this Item will be taken later.

Item 92-9 - Proposed Catalog Changes from the Department of Elementary and Jr. High School Education

M. E. Varble/B. Findley moved to place this Item on the agenda. The motion carried unanimously. Dr. Helwig, Chair of the Department, requested that the COECC suspend the rules and vote on this proposal in order for the new Catalog copy to reflect the coursework which will comply and satisfy the E.I.U. integrated core and the State Board of Education's General Education requirements. The Department feels that this is a necessary step in order to be able to provide future guidelines for the advisement of students. P. Overton/S. Garner moved to suspend the rules and vote today. Item 92-9 was approved unanimously by the COECC.
