On the Shoulders of Giants: The Moon and Beyond

The library's exhibition commemorating the 50th anniversary of the first moon landing is on display in the Marvin Foyer. The exhibit examines the first moon landing made on July 20, 1969, by Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin, as well as considers current and future space exploration. Display topics include EIU alumni connections to the space program; biographies of various astronauts; space exploration today and in the future; women participation in space exploration; and more. The exhibit will be on display until May 31, 2019.

Use Global Newsstream for Newspaper Articles

Global Newsstream is a great news resource available from the library website. Students can search it for the most recent newspaper articles, or for content dating back to the 1980s. The database contains more than 2,800 news sources including newspapers, newswires, news journals, transcripts, video, and digital-first content in full-text format. It has a collection of news sources from the U.S., Canada, Europe, Africa, Asia, Latin America, and Australia. Use *Global Newsstream* to find articles from the **Wall Street Journal**, **Washington Post**, **New York Times**, and **Chicago Tribune**.

It has peer-reviewed journal articles, magazine articles, book chapters, reports, and more.
