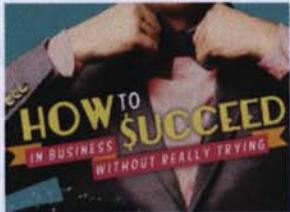

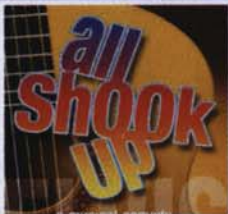

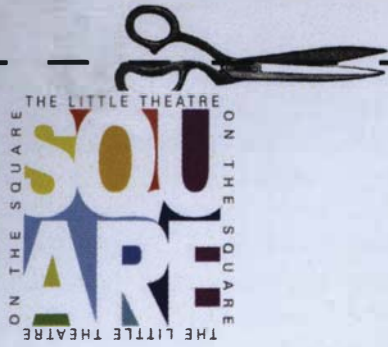
SHEAR MADNESS • AUG. 10 - 21
