CHARLESTON -- Twenty-three reporters from 17 Illinois newspapers will attend the 16th annual Illinois Press Association Reporters Short Course this week at Eastern Illinois University.

The workshop will begin Wednesday at 7 p.m. and continue through Saturday afternoon in Blair Hall. Separate sessions will be held for beginning and advanced reporters.

The EIU Department of Journalism is offering the workshop in conjunction with Illinois Press Association. Members of the journalism faculty will teach most sessions.
