MINUTES OF THE COLLEGE OF FINE ARTS
CURRICULUM COMMITTEE
February 24, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the chair, Gary Zwicky, at 4:00 p.m. in room FAM 219.

Members Present: Jeff Boshart, James Johnson (Art); Gary Zwicky (Music); C.P. Blanchette (Theatre); Vaughn Jaenike (Ex Officio)

Members Excused: Herman Taylor (Music); E.T. Guidotti (Theatre); Beverly Gartin (Dean's Office)

The minutes from the November 11, 1991 meeting were approved.

Proposals submitted:

Music Performance Majors in the Vocal Emphasis

Reduction from 8 s.h. to 6 s.h. in the foreign language requirement. Rationale: The original intent was 2 semesters (1 yr) of language. Foreign language courses have been changed from 4 s.h. to 3 s.h. Boshart moved to accept and Blanchette seconded the motion. The Motion passed unanimously.

ART 5850 - "Art Intern Seminar"

Change of course name from "Art Intern Seminar" to "Teaching Practicum." The course description will remain exactly the same. Rationale: Both the Art Dept. and the Council on Graduate Studies recommend the change because the word "intern" in the current title is not compatible with an "internship" as applied to this course. Boshart moved to accept and Blanchette seconded the motion. The Motion passed unanimously.

These proposals will be presented for approval by Acting Vice President Hill by executive action.

There was discussion of the proposed LAS minorities courses requirement in that college.

Motion passed to adjourn meeting at 4:50. The Committee will meet as needed.

Note: According to the CAA there will be moratorium on consideration of new courses for general education for one year from the date of implementation (Fall 1992), unless the CAA requests courses, with the exception of Honors courses and Senior Seminars.
