





Guy S. Little, Jr., producer, owner and managing director of The Little Theatre-On The Square in Sullivan, Illinois opened "central Illinois' only professional Equity star musical and dramatic theatre" on July 3, 1957 and is currently celebrating his 22nd season. Since 1957, Mr. Little has presented 228 major productions and come May 20 of this year, 3000 performances have been viewed by Central Illinois audiences. Many of the great stars from Broadway and Hollywood have appeared in Sullivan including Alan Alda, June Allyson, Eve Arden, Jean-Pierre Aumont, Bill Bixby, Joe E. Brown, Imogene Coca, Dorothy Collins, Robert Cummings, Andy Devine, Betty Grable, Mimi Hines, Edward Everett Horton, Van Johnson, Harvey Korman, Peter Marshall, Ray Milland, Ann Miller, Leonard Nimoy, Pat O'Brien, Cesar Romero, Ann Sothern, Margaret Truman, Vivian Vance, Dennis Weaver and JoAnne Worley . . . to name just a few.



Mr. Little decided at the age of six when he saw his first stage production that he wanted to have a theatre. He began his career at the age of sixteen working as an apprentice in Keene, New Hampshire and the following two summers, completed his apprenticeship at a theatre near Atlantic City, New Jersey. He was a scholarship student through the opera department at the University of Miami in Florida and spent three seasons appearing with the famed Miami Opera Guild appearing in the chorus and supporting roles with the outstanding stars from the Met and other famed opera companies. Mr. Little graduated from the U. of M. in 1956 with a B.A. in theatre, moved to New York where he worked on his master's at Columbia University and took graduate courses in theatre at the American Theatre Wing.

In addition to presenting productions in Sullivan, Mr. Little has produced touring productions which have been presented in New York, Ohio, Michigan, Connecticut and Colorado. He was employed as Managing Director-Producer at the famed Sombra Playhouse in Phoenix, Arizona and at the Piccolo Playhouse in Joliet; he has served as Production Stage Manager at the Coconut Grove Playhouse in Miami.

At the age of 43, Mr. Little is looking forward to producing at least another thirty seasons at The Little Theatre-On The Square.


