CHARLESTON, IL.--The Department of Health Education will become the Department of Health Studies at Eastern Illinois University.

Approval for the change was granted Thursday (May 8) at the May meeting of the Board of Governors in Springfield.

"Changing the name of the department reflects the shift in student demand and in job opportunities that has taken place in the field in the past several years," said EIU President Stan Rives.

"Positions are no longer limited to persons working in schools who require teacher certification, and opportunities are growing in the areas of public health and health agency administration," he explained.

The Board also approved two more asbestos abatement projects for removal of all asbestos insulation in the heating plant and Booth Library at an estimated cost slightly over \$300,000.

"The University will now contract for professional engineering services for the preparation of bidding specifications for this project," said Rives.

DeMoulin Brothers & Company, Greenville, was the approved vendor to provide 200 University marching band uniforms, 75 concert attire, 25 color guard uniforms and 28 show choir uniforms at a cost of \$58,642.69.

These garments are being purchased to replace marching band uniforms and flag corps uniforms purchased in 1977, and concert dress purchased in 1976. Show choir garments have never previously been provided.
