About the Scenic Designer . . .

ROBERT D. SOULE returns to the Little Theatre-On The Square for the sixth season as resident designer. Audiences will remember the strikingly beautiful and miraculously workable sets he designed for *The Student Prince*, *Glad Tidings*, *Picnic*, *Guys And Dolls*, *The Sound Of Music*, *George M!*, *The Music Man* and many others. A professional designer for many years, Mr. Soule has made his home in New York City for the past 20 years where he has designed for over 30 theatre productions as well as for television and movies. Born in Bushnell, Illinois, he studied at Western Illinois University and the Pasadena Playhouse in

California before becoming a member of the United Scenic Artists union. He has designed for some of the most famous theatres in the country including the Coconut Grove in Miami, Sombrero Playhouse in Phoenix, Casa Manana in Ft. Worth, Texas and many East Coast Theatres. He went to Edinburg, Scotland immediately after leaving Sullivan in 1968, to co-ordinate designs for the Providence Repertoire Company's production at the Edinburg Festival. The past three years, he served as resident-designer at Trinity Square Rep Theatre of Rhode Island.

WELCOME TO THE SEVENTEENTH SEASON!



Much to its surprise, in July, 1957, the little town of Sullivan, Illinois became the home of a "live" stage theatre. Guy S. Little, Jr., native of Sullivan, opened the old Grand movie house with a "Summer Of Musicals" which began with "Brigadoon". Determination and an interesting schedule that first year established that Mr. Little was going to bring theatre art to Central Illinois, come what may! The first season continued with "WONDERFUL TOWN", "ROBERTA", "KISS ME KATE", "SONG OF NORWAY", "CALL ME MADAM", "WISH YOU WERE HERE", "FINIAN'S RAINBOW" and "GUYS AND DOLLS". In 1962, two straight plays were incorporated into the season's schedule, "THE TUNNEL OF LOVE" and "THE GLASS MENAGERIE".

Although Mr. Little was "new" in the position of being a producer, his educational and working background prepared him well for the purpose. While at the University of Miami, he spent three seasons with the

famed Miami Opera Guild, appearing in support of leading Metropolitan Opera singers. While still in high school, he completed three seasons as a performer and technician at leading theatres in the East. Now, after sixteen years, he has become a pivotal influence in the world of professional stock theatre and in the lives of hundreds of young theatre-minded aspirants. He has brought one hundred and eighty one major productions to Central Illinois audiences. From a total attendance in 1957 of 8,000, 1972 brought nearly 100,000 patrons to The Little Theatre-On The Square!

In addition to casting, staffing and producing all of the productions at The Little Theatre-On The Square, Mr. Little has presented musicals on tour throughout the Mid-west and has served as producer at the Sombrero Playhouse in Phoenix and the Piccolo Playhouse in Joliet. This past winter, Mr. Little served as Production Stage Manager at the Coconut Grove Playhouse in Miami for three months, working with Howard Keel, Frank Gorshin, Hume Cronyn, Jessica Tandy, and Shelley Winters. 1973 marks Mr. Little's 22nd year of working in professional theatre.

In February and March each year, the busy producer auditions and interviews over four hundred people for performing talent and staff positions in New York, Chicago and Sullivan. Approximately one hundred and fifty of these are apprentice applicants out of which twenty to thirty are selected for professional training in Sullivan in all phases of theatre. Only the most experienced and talented staff heads are engaged to assist in training the young apprentice company each season.

Although Mr. Little occasionally appears in a production, little does the general public know the "behind-the-scene" story about this energetic man. He assists in all areas of the theatre, giving a helping hand in any and all departments. He might be seen working at his desk a few moments before a performance, greeting patrons as the doors are opened, taking orders on the box office phones, sewing the last minute touches on a costume, putting on make-up for a walk-on part in the show, dashing home to put some delectable dish together for later in the evening for the star and company after the show, taping a radio or television interview or one of a hundred other things!

Mr. Little has been blessed with a family, mother, father, wife and children who are all talented in varied fields. Mr. Little, Sr., actually is a Farm Manager although, he laughingly refers to himself as "a-dollar-a-year-man" as he goes about the duties of business manager for the theatre. Mrs. Little, Sr. has appeared in several earlier productions as well as handling the duties of box office manager. Jerili Little has appeared in over sixty productions at The Little Theatre-On The Square and is acclaimed in other leading theatres for starring roles. Vanessa has held her professional Actors' Equity Card for seven years and has appeared in many Sullivan productions and Sean has also been in many of the major shows and Children's Theatre productions.

Each season as the curtain rises on THE opening night of the year, Guy S. Little, Jr. receives applause after his personal welcoming message to the first-nighters but, as he accepts this applause, he is also applauding his loyal patrons for making his theatre a success for the past sixteen years!

Who's Who in the Cast . . .

GEORGE CHAKIRIS (Artnur) laid the foundation of a major motion picture career with his arresting Oscar-winning portrayal of Bernardo in *West Side Story*. This apparent overnight success was actually the result of some years of hard work and preparation. He began by obtaining small dancing roles in a number of pictures. He then journeyed to New York hoping to find that elusive big break on the Broadway stage. Hearing that Jerome Robbins was casting the London stage production of *West Side Story*, he auditioned and was awarded the role of Riff. The opening in London was a considerable triumph and he enjoyed the success for some twenty months. By then, Robbins and Robert Wise were in Hollywood casting the film version and Mr. Chakiris was called for a screen test and was cast for the totally different role of Bernardo. Upon the first screening, he received unanimous enthusiastic reviews from an excited press.

Between pictures he made successful personal appearances at Caesar's Palace and The Riviera Hotel in Las Vegas and Harrah's in Lake Tahoe and has made numerous record albums for Capitol Records.

Television appearances include *Hawaii Five-O*, *Medical Center*, *Police Surgeon* and *The Carol Burnett Show*.

Shortly before coming to Sullivan, Mr. Chakiris starred nationally in the Broadway hit, *Company*.

JAY STUART (Lancelot) was featured with Lauren Bacall on Broadway in *Applause* and in *Cry For Us All*. He was the leading man in Richard Rodgers' New York revival of *The Boys From Syracuse* and co-starred with Ray Bolger in the National Touring Company of *The Happy Time*. Mr. Stuart has played both Don Quixote and Dr. Carrasco in five companies of *The Man Of La Mancha* and has appeared in leading theatres throughout the country in many musicals including the roles of Edward Rutledge in *1776*, Michael in *I Do!
