CHARLESTON--Dina Chapman, daughter of Ralph and Karla Chapman of Prairie duRocher, recently received the Ruth Gaertner Scholarship at Eastern Illinois University.

The scholarship is awarded annually to a junior dietetics student who rates high in respect, assumption of responsibilities and scholarship.
