CHARLESTON, IL--Three Eastern Illinois University choral groups will present a concert on Thursday, Feb. 24 at 8 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall.

The Mixed Chorus, directed by John N. Maharg, will open the program with Peter Philips' motet, "Regina coeli." The chorus will also sing the spiritual "I've been 'buked" and "Almighty God of our Fathers" by Will James

The Cecilian Singers, directed by James Brinkman, will sing Handel's "Serve The Lord With Gladness" and "Movin On" by Hannisian. Steve Cannedy and Thomas Bowen, graduate student conductors, will direct a portion of the program.

Robert E. Snyder conducts the Concert Choir. The Choir will perform Poulene's "Mass in G," one of the composer's great works. The group will also sing "I Want To Live In Canaan Land" by Newbury and "Stomp Your Feet" by Aaron Copland. The latter will be conducted by Patty Cunningham, a graduate student conductor.
