SPRING SEMESTER REGISTRATION AT EIU BEGINS JANUARY 9

CHARLESTON, IL.--Spring semester registration at Eastern Illinois University begins Saturday, January 9.

Graduate students who have not pre-enrolled for spring at EIU may register between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and noon on Saturday, January 9 or on Monday and Tuesday, January 11 and 12, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Undergraduates register on Monday and Tuesday only. Registration activities on all three days begin at McAfee Building.

New or re-entering students registering on these dates are scheduled for specific times and have received instructions by mail. Late registration is permitted through Friday, January 15.

Orientation for beginning freshmen and undergraduate transfers is held in Phipps Lecture Hall of the Science Building and students required to attend have been notified.

Academic advisors will be available at McAfee Building for both graduate and undergraduate registration days.

Program changes (adds and drops) are scheduled for Wednesday, January 13 through Friday, January 15 in the EIU Union Ballroom. The hours will be from 8:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday and from 1:00 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. on Thursday and Friday.

The maximum load for undergraduates in good academic standing is 18 hours, while the load for students on academic warning or probation is 15.
