Symphonette To Present Winter Concert

The Eastern Illinois University Symphonette will present its winter concert on Sunday, February 26 at 4 p.m. in the Fine Arts Theater.

The orchestra, conducted by Dr. Earl Boyd, will perform "Suite From The Water Music" by Handel; "Symphony No. 8 in B Minor" by Schubert; "Andante Con Tenerezza" from Symphony No. 2 by Hanson; "Quiet City" by Copland; and "Sunday Afternoon At The Movies" by Reed.

John Schuster, English horn, and Dr. George Westcott, trumpet, are soloists in "Quiet City," composed for English horn, trumpet, and strings.

Donald Reed, director of Eastern's stage band, has written a special arrangement of tunes from "The Sandpiper," "Goldfinger," and "Dr. Zhivago" for the Symphonette, and will conduct the orchestra in the work.
