# Bovce McCormick Helps In Tokvo Occupation

— *Oct. 11, '45*

On the USS Mt. Olympus in Tokyo Bay, Sept. 15 (Delayed) — Boyce B. McCormick, motor machinist's mate, second class, son of Mr. and Mrs. Roy McCormack of Newton, Ill., is serving on this communication headquarters ship, which was among the first U. S. Navy vessels to enter Tokyo Bay.

The Mount Olympus, flagship of Vice Admiral T. S. Wilkinson, arrived at dawn of the day of the Japs surrendered.
