CHARLESTON, IL--Kelly Waldrup (Coulterville), sophomore guard, is a member of Eastern Illinois University women's basketball squad. She has appeared in 13 of the Panthers' 16 contests.

Averaging 2.3 points per game, Waldrup had a season high game of 14 points in Eastern's first game of the 1980-81 campaign, a 117-22 win over Maryville College.

"Kelly shoots extremely well off the pick," said head coach Bobbie Hilke, whose Panthers are 10-6 on the season. "She possesses a lot of hustle and is a very good defense player," Hilke added.

In addition, Hilke cited Waldrup as being "a team player, one who comes off the bench well."

Waldrup, a physical education major, is a 1979 graduate of Coulterville High School where she was named to the Southern Illinois All-Star Team her senior year. She is the daughter of Roger and Carlene Waldrup of Coulterville.
