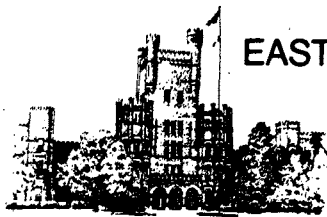

CHARLESTON, IL--Violinist Barbara Sturgis-Everett, an Assistant Professor of Music at Eastern Illinois University, will present a recital on Tuesday, March 1 at 8 p.m. in Dvorak Hall.

Dr. Catherine Smith, pianist, will collaborate with Ms. Sturgis-Everett in performing Mozart's Sonata in B flat Major, K.454 and Brahms' Sonata No. 2 in A Major, Op. 100.

The duo will also perform the premiere of Lingo, written for Ms. Sturgis-Everett by Henry Gwiazda, Assistant Professor of Music at Moorhead State University. The composer "seeks a spontaneous, improvisatory style through jazz idioms."

Ms. Sturgis-Everett will play Reminiscences: Five Miniatures for Unaccompanied Violin by Peter Hesterman, Associate Professor at Eastern. Each of the Reminiscences "parodies characteristics of the string writing of a composer active in the first half of the 20th century."

A doctoral candidate at the University of Cincinnati's College-Conservatory of Music, Ms. Sturgis-Everett holds bachelor's and master's degrees in music from Peabody Conservatory of Music in Baltimore.
