SHILOH EDUCATOR IS A "PRIME TIME TEACHER"

CHARLESTON – Leigh Schindewolf, a teacher at Shiloh Village School, was a featured speaker at the 46<sup>th</sup> annual Conference on the Teaching of Mathematics, held March 4 at Eastern Illinois University.

Schindewolf, a 1997 graduate of EIU, discussed hands-on approaches to teaching probability.

According to Andrew White, EIU faculty member and chairman of the conference, Schindewolf was one of only 42 teachers invited to make presentations at this year's conference. More than 200 teachers were considered.

Robert Grimm, 2002-2003 Illinois Teacher of the Year, was the conference's keynote speaker. Grimm received his master's degree from Eastern, as well.

Nearly 300 teachers attended the event.
