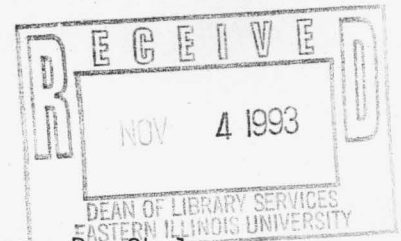

Item 94-2 - Proposed Revision - Physical Education Minor w/Teacher Certification

Dr. Church, Chair of the Physical Education Department, indicated that the changes being proposed are due to the State's increase in requirements. The courses ZOO 2001C, PED 1600, and 1692 have been added. She stated that lifetime sports are being stressed more and more. F. Summers/M. Rawlins moved that the Committee accept this program. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 94-4 - Revised Health Studies Major & Minor w/Teacher Certification Option

R. Bates informed the members that in order to meet the new State requirements for certification in the area of Health Education, revisions have been made in the Major and Minor. F. Summers/R. Bates moved to waive the rules and vote on this Item today. F. Summers/R. Bates moved to pass this Item.

Item 94-1 - ByLaws Revision

94-5 - New Course Proposal, HST 3120 - American Red Cross Instructor

This course is designed to replace HST 3100 - Standard First Aid Instruction and HST 3001 - CPS Instructor with updated Red Cross First Aid and CPR instructor training. HST 3120 will offer the Instructor Candidate Training (ICT) course along with the requirements for the revamped Red Cross First Aid and CPR Instructor. F. Summers/R. Gholson moved to place this Item on the agenda for future action.
