CHARLESTON, IL --Dr. Mark Wait, Assistant Professor of Piano at the University of Colorado, will conduct a master class and demonstration with students, and a public concert at Eastern Illinois University on Monday, Oct. 13 in the Dvorak Concert Hall.

The concert, sponsored by Eastern, will be presented at 8 p.m. The piano master class, sponsored by the University and the National Piano Foundation, will be from 10 a.m. to noon and from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Dr. Catherine Smith, Music Department faculty member, said the classes will be for private studio teachers and for school teachers. She said visual interest will be provided by local young persons and University students who will serve as pupils during the demonstration part of the class.

At the concert, Wait will perform works by Mozart, Webern, Boulez and Scriabin.

Wait was educated at Wichita State University, Kansas State University, and the Peabody Conservatory of Music in Baltimore. In 1977 he was a member of the piano faculty at the National Music Camp, Interlochen, Mich.

His recent concert appearances include the world premiere of Morris Cotel's "Tehom" at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and a lecture-recital at the National Convention of the American Liszt Society.
