ROGERS RECIPIENT OF MODGLIN SCHOLARSHIP

CHARLESTON -- Jennifer Rogers, daughter of W.L. Rogers of London, England, and Barbara Jenson of Pleasant Plains, is the recipient of the Carolyn Kluesner Modglin Memorial Scholarship at Eastern Illinois University.

The scholarship was established to honor Carolyn Kluesner, a graduate assistant in the School of Home Economics in 1990-91. After completing her M.S. in Home Economics - Dietetics, she married, became a registered dietitian, and worked as a clinical dietitian. After her death in 1993, some of her classmates helped establish the scholarship in her memory. Contributions by her family and friends endowed a scholarship to be awarded annually to an Eastern graduate student in dietetics or foods and nutrition.

A 1989 graduate of Pleasant Plains High School, Rogers is a graduate student in dietetics at Eastern.

Eastern, which is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 1994-95, is a comprehensive university with more than 10,500 students and 46 undergraduate and 27 graduate degree programs. It is a teaching institution which prides itself on the quality and affordability of its undergraduate program.
