TALK AT EIU TO DISCUSS U.S./UNITED NATIONS RELATIONSHIP

CHARLESTON -- Paul Diehl, professor of political science at the University of Illinois-Urbana, will deliver a talk on the relationship between the United States and United Nations in the Post-Cold War Era .

He will present this information at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 2, in Eastern Illinois University's Lumpkin Hall, Room 122. Admission is free and open to the public.

Diehl is the author and/or co-author of 13 books and more than 80 scholarly articles and book chapters on international organizations and the causes of war. He is a nationally recognized expert on peacekeeping and peace-enforcement operations.
