# JOHN WILSON IN GERMAN PRISON

*April 26, 1945*

**BOGOTA BOY WRITES PARENTS HE  
IS WELL AND SAFE**

Mr and Mrs D. N. Wilson, of Bogota, have received word from their son, John, that he is safe in a German prison camp. This is the first word received from him since the parents were notified by the war department that he was missing in action as of January 1.
