CHARLESTON, IL --The chief of the Eastern Virginia Bureau of the Richmond (Va.) Times-Dispatch, W. Wilford Kale, Jr., is a guest lecturer this week for the Journalism Department at Eastern Illinois University.

Kale is national president of the Society for Collegiate Journalists (SCJ). He will confer with David Reed, a journalism faculty member and SCJ secretary-treasurer.

A Times-Dispatch reporter since 1966, Kale has covered presidential visits by Lyndon Johnson, Richard Nixon, Gerald R. Ford and Jimmy Carter. He has reported on foreign dignitaries, including a 1975 trip by Emperor Hirohito of Japan.

Kale won an award in 1978 for a series of articles on an admission controversy in higher education in Virginia.

Kale was educated at William and Mary, Park College in Kansas City, Mo., and George Washington University. In 1969-70, he served as a public information officer in Vietnam.
