CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's women cagers will face a big challenge Thursday (Feb. 9) night.

The Lady Panthers will face the Gateway Collegiate Conference's tallest starting lineup at Drake University in Des Moines, IA as Eastern attempts to upset the league's second place team.

The Bulldogs boast four starters at least 6 feet tall, including All-American candidate Lorri Bauman, who leads the GCAC with a 29.7 point scoring average. In addition to the 6-3 Bauman, Drake coach Carole Baumgarten will send three forwards--6-0 Wanda Ford, 6-2 Dawn Wumkes and 6-1 Kay Riek against the Panthers.

Ford has proven to be an outstanding complement to Bauman and currently leads the Gateway with 14.1 rebounds per contest.

The Lady Panthers will attempt to counter Drake's height advantage with a tenacious defense, which produced 28 turnovers in the two teams' last meeting, a 70-59 Bulldog victory on Jan. 14.

"We did a good job defensively on them out front the first time," EIU head coach Bobbie Hilke said. "We just need to be more patient on offense.

"If we can convert some of the pressure mistakes that we create, we have a chance to come out of there with a win. That's only been done 18 times, but I think we have a shot at it," Hilke added, referring to the Bulldogs' outstanding 82-18 record at the Drake Fieldhouse.

An Eastern victory would put the Panthers back in the thick of the GCAC race behind league-leading Southern Illinois. The Salukis stand alone with a perfect 9-0 mark, followed by Drake and Illinois State at 7-2. The Lady Panthers and Wichita State are currently tied for fourth with 6-3 records.

Following the Thursday night encounter at Drake, Eastern will travel to Cedar Falls, IA to face the conference's last place team, Northern Iowa. UNI has managed only one

victory in 18 tries this season and has yet to beat a GCAC team. The last time the two teams squared off, Eastern came away with an easy 77-51 victory.
