TRENDS COURSE OFFERED AT PARKLAND

CHARLESTON, IL--Trends that will take us into the year 2000 and beyond and how technology is impacting our future will be the focus of a one semester hour weekend course offered by Eastern Illinois University at Parkland College.

"Trends that are Shaping Our Future" will be offered from 6 to 10 p.m. Friday, Feb. 4 and 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 5 in Room X223 at Parkland College. Louis Butler, an associate professor in Eastern's School of Technology, is the instructor.

The course, offered by the Champaign/Ford Regional Office of Education in cooperation with the School of Adult and Continuing Education at Eastern, will deal with trends from a global perspective, using human resources, environmental, economic and social cultural indicators. Group interaction will be encouraged.

There are no prerequisites for this introductory course.
