SOVIET UNION SEMINAR SET

CHARLESTON, IL--Dr. Anita Shelton of the Eastern Illinois University History Department will present a seminar on "Why is Mikhail Gorbachev Afraid of Alexander Solzhenitsyn? or: How Far Can Glasnost Go?" on Thursday, January 19, 1989, in the Board of Governors Room of Eastern's Booth Library at 3:30 p.m.

The public, students, faculty, and staff are invited to attend. The seminar is sponsored jointly by the Eastern History Club and History Department.

Dr. Shelton joined Eastern's faculty this fall after teaching a year at Seattle University. She has an M.A. from the Jackson School of International Studies and a Ph.D. from the University of Washington, and has received both Fulbright and International Exchange Fellowships for advanced study in Poland. Her dissertation on Polish historian Franciszek Bujak is being prepared for publication by Columbia University press.
