CHARLESTON, IL --A "Clinic for Couples" will be offered at Eastern Illinois University beginning Saturday, Jan. 30. Participants will have an opportunity "to learn new dimensions in communicating as couples, families, or friends," according to a spokesman for the Office of Public Service and Development, the clinic's sponsor.

Participants will meet monthly on four Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 12 noon in the Buzzard Education building. Clinic leaders will be Dr. Robert Saltmarsh and Dr. Melanie Rawlins, teachers in the department of Educational Psychology and Guidance. Saltmarsh is a registered psychologist in private practice and Dr. Rawlins is an effectiveness training instructor.

The clinic will provide persons "with the unique advantage of being in a support group with other couples." Tuition for the clinic is \$80 per couple. Registration may be done by calling 581-3817.
