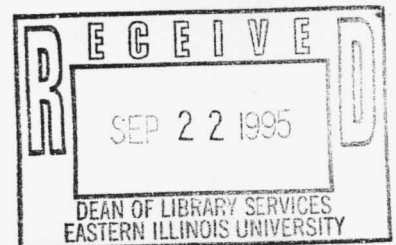
On the Agenda in the Future:
