NOMINATIONS FOR 'WOMEN OF ACHIEVEMENT' SOUGHT

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University's Women's Studies Council encourages area resident to nominate women who have made significant contributions to their community and/or to Eastern for the annual "Women of Achievement" Awards.

These awards will be part of the celebration of Women's History and Awareness Month in March. Eastern students, faculty, civil service employees and women in the community are eligible to be considered for the award.

Awards will be given to women who meet any combination of the following criteria: acts as a role model worthy of emulation; helps in advancing the progress of women's causes; participates in women's professional and/or community organizations; demonstrably defends women's rights and champions the cause of equity; and makes outstanding contributions in service to the university and/or community.

Anyone is eligible to nominate women who have significantly improved the quality of women's lives and advanced the status of women in the area.
