## AREA STUDENTS ON EIU DEAN'S LIST

CHARLESTON -- Approximately 700 students have been named to Eastern Illinois University's Fall 1995 Dean's List.

To be named to the Dean's List, a student must be in the top 10 percent of his or her college while carrying a full course load.

The same eligibility requirements apply to students with undeclared majors and those enrolled in the Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts degree program.

Students from Eastern's four colleges (Arts and Humanities; Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences; Education and Professional Studies; and Sciences) are included on the Dean's List.

Eastern, located in Charleston, is a public, residential university that places priority on teaching excellence. More than 11,000 students are enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs.
