CHARLESTON, IL--Mrs. Nancy Froelich, of Lake Bloomington, Chairman of the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities, participated in a testimonial dinner Sunday (Jan. 11) for H Ogden Brainard, a Charleston attorney for more than 50 years.

As part of the ceremony, the building that houses the Eastern Illinois University Foundation was formally named the H Ogden Brainard House.

Brainard played a major role in organizing the Foundation in 1953. Mrs. Froelich congratulated him for his work with the Foundation. She said that Eastern's Foundation has grown more in the past two and one-half years than the foundations in the four other BOG schools--Western, Chicago State, Northeastern and Governors State.
