CHARLESTON, IL--Kathy Lanter (Georgetown), sophomore guard, is a member of Eastern Illinois University women's basketball team which has compiled a 10-6 record mid-way through the 1980-81 season.

Averaging 5.3 points and 2.6 rebounds per game, Kathy had a season high game of 13 points in the Panthers' 94-77 win over Northern Michigan. She has 18 assists and 11 steals to her credit.

"Kathy is an excellent outside shooter, especially on the baseline. We'll be going to her more and more against a zone defense," said head coach Bobbie Hilke.

"She has exceptional mobility and has the "best hands" of anybody on the team," Hilke added.

"She is excellent coming off the bench . . . really sparks us. In a reserve role, she is doing an outstanding job," said Hilke.

Kathy, a physical education major, is the daughter of Jerry and Margaret Lanter of 206 McKinley, Georgetown. She is a 1979 graduate of Georgetown High School where she was an Honorable Mention All-State guard.
