On Saturday, April 26 – egg hunt and homemade play dough, 9:30 to 10:30 a.m., Taylor Hall; duck pond with prizes, 10 to 11 a.m., Lawson Hall; sidewalk chalking and more, 10:30 to 11:30 a.m., Pemberton Hall; picnic, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., Library Quad; an all-campus scavenger hunt, hula hoop contest and face painting, 12:30 to 2 p.m., Lincoln Hall; dodgeball, 1:30 to 2:30 p.m., Ford Hall; fun and games, 2 to 3 p.m., Andrews Hall; coloring, cartoons and musical chairs, 2:30 to 3:30 p.m., Weller Hall; and bowling, 4 to 6 p.m., University Union Bowling Alley.

Campus maps will be available during the day so that visitors can easily find their way around campus.

All events are free, with the exception of bowling (\$1.75 per game w/ free shoe rental) and the picnic lunch (\$3 per person).
