CHARLESTON, IL--Two non-credit introductory courses in microcomputers will be offered at Eastern Illinois University on Mondays and Wednesdays from 7 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. beginning Feb. 27 and March 12.

The courses are open to anyone interested in microcomputers and their applications. No previous experience with computers is needed. Three applications of microcomputers will be taught: word processing, file management and spread sheets.

Content will be identical for both courses and each will be held in room 304 of Eastern's administration building (Old Main). Each course will run two weeks and will include instruction on IBM Personal Computers.

The courses are designed to give students the ability to evaluate areas in which they can use computers in their work or home and prepare them for detailed computer work. Participants will be given time to further explore a topic on their own with guidance from the instructors.

Instructors will be Dr. Hal Anderson of Eastern's Mathematics Department and Dr. Anthony Schaeffer of Eastern's Computer Services Department.

A registration fee of \$90 per person or \$140 for a team sharing a computer is required. Registration may be completed by calling the Office of Continuing Education at 581-5115.
