CHARLESTON, IL--Forty-two charter members of the President's Club of the Eastern Illinois University Foundation have been honored.

Specially designed plaques were presented at a luncheon to 38 individuals and four corporations. Making the presentations were Dr. Stanley Rives, EIU president; Mrs. Evelyn Kaufman, Board of Governors (BOG) chairwoman, and Dr. Tom Layzell, BOG executive director.

The Club was started in December 1984 by Rives as an initial effort in EIU's new development program called Tenth Decade Campaign. The Coles County university's Foundation has set a goal of raising \$5 million in five years.

Membership in the President's Club is awarded to individuals making gifts of \$1,000 or more annually. Corporations must contribute \$5,000 or more annually.

The Club, organized within the EIU Foundation, has as its primary goal the establishment of "an exemplary pattern of substantial giving to the University by alumni, faculty, staff and friends for the support and improvement of the undergraduate and graduate programs of Eastern Illinois University."
