CHARLESTON – Eastern Illinois University invites all parents of senior class college-bound high school students to "A Different Kind of Financial Aid Night," scheduled to take place at 7 p.m. Monday, Feb. 28.

The evening's activities will guide parents through the process of completing the FAFSA form -- the gateway form that determines a student's eligibility for all types of federal student financial aid, including Pell grants, subsidized student loans and unsubsidized student loans. In addition, almost all schools use the data from a FAFSA to qualify a student for public and private scholarships.

Representatives of Eastern's Office of Financial Aid will begin the evening with a general session, then walk participants through the line-by-line completion of the FAFSA. In addition, they'll demonstrate internet completion which allows for a faster processing time.

There will be opportunities for financial aid staff to assist participants and answer questions, both privately and in a group setting.

The event, free of charge, is open to all parents of senior students in the area, and is not limited to parents of prospective EIU students.
