CHARLESTON, IL --Nominations for Distinguished Alumnus Awards at Eastern Illinois University are being accepted, according to Charles Titus, Director of Alumni Services.

Eligible for nominations are "alumni and former students who have distinguished themselves in academic, literary, business, professional or public service careers, or who through their accomplishments and service have brought credit to themselves and to Eastern Illinois University."

The awards will be presented at Homecoming on Oct. 9, Titus said.

Nominations should be submitted in writing and supported by documentation citing achievements and accomplishments of the nominees. Titus said resumes, lists of honors and awards and similar material "are the kinds of things the selection committee is looking for."

All materials should be mailed to the Distinguished Alumnus Awards Committee, Alumni Office, Eastern Illinois University, Charleston.

The joint faculty/alumni committee was named by Dr. Daniel E. Marvin, Jr., Eastern's president. Nominations should be received no later than April 23.

This will be the tenth year for alumni to be formally recognized for their achievements, Titus said.
