CHARLESTON, IL--In observation of Black History Month, the departments of sociology and Afro-American Studies have scheduled two speakers.

Dr. Arthur J. Cox, Associate Professor of Social Work, Southern Illinois University, will speak on "The Black Family: An Institution In Crisis" on Wednesday, Feb. 13 at 7:30 p.m. in the Booth Library Lecture Hall.

Cox was a social worker in Harlem before receiving a doctorate from Columbia University. He is the author of 14 articles and monographs.
