CHARLESTON, IL --John Sellett, a sophomore at Eastern Illinois University from Charleston, is a 1980 recipient of the President's Award. Sellett's award carried a certificate and a stipend of \$150.

Candidates for the award were the top 20 students in the freshman class "who have done all their college work at Eastern and who have completed their freshman requirements during the 1980 spring semester." Three awards were presented.

A faculty committee appointed by President Daniel E. Marvin, Jr. evaluated the candidates on the basis of high academic records "and evidence of demonstrated qualities of leadership and a desire to serve others."
