CUNNINGHAM AWARDED UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH GRANT AT EIU

CHARLESTON – Jason B. Cunningham, a senior biological sciences major at Eastern Illinois University, recently was awarded a Fall 2003 undergraduate research grant.

This \$500 grant, awarded by EIU's Undergraduate Research Council through the university's Honors Program, will allow Cunningham to continue work on his project, "Seasonal Effects on Seed Quality of Two Native Herbaceous Perennials."

To be eligible for an undergraduate research grant, a student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and be conducting research under the direction of a faculty sponsor. A limited number of such grants are awarded each semester.

Cunningham, a 1999 graduate of East Richland High School in Olney, is the son of David and Earlene Cunningham of Olney. His faculty sponsor in the research is Janice Coons, a professor in Eastern's Department of Biological Sciences.
